THE WELL, NEW RESOURCE IN PANDEMIC ERA: Bishop Vincent this week launched an initiative in the Diocese for all of us to stay connected with the Church and each other. He said: "I am pleased to share with you the latest initiative from our ministries and agencies which responds to the growing need for a strong Catholic presence online. This need is only accentuated during this time of the pandemic. Through our work with our youth, with our parishes and our councils, we have understood the importance of offering a relevant and engaging online space, and what is being offered seeks to support and complement the work of our faith communities, as we work together to share and grow our faith in Jesus Christ.
